

2017 CAPITOL RACEWAY JUNIOR DRAGSTER PROGRAM RULES

- All IHRA Junior Dragster rules apply.
- Juniors must sign up with IHRA for their membership number; you do not earn points until you have your number.
- To earn points a driver must sign up before the 1st round of eliminations.
- Race entry fee is \$30 (car/driver) & \$15 per crew member.
- Gates will open at 9:00am & time runs begin at 12:00pm.
- 8 & 9 year olds will line up in lanes 7(R) & 8(L).
- 10 & up will line up in lanes 9(R) & 10(L).
- You will have 2 time runs, after you run your first time run, return to the pits & wait to be called back to the lanes for your second time run. Your second time run will be your qualifying run. Return to the pits & wait to be called for 1st round eliminations.
- Although we are running one class for juniors, 8 & 9 year olds will be paired first, with 10 & up to follow. The last junior winner of 8 & 9 will move into the 10 & up class for one final winner.
- The best reaction time will determine possible buy run, if there are identical reaction times the first driver with the best reaction time will receive the buy. Driver is only eligible for one true buy during eliminations. A driver may not decline the buy but you may break the beam & then return to the end of the lane.
- If you lose 1st round you may buy back into 2nd round for \$10. Payment will be taken in staging lanes & you will continue to receive points.
- Points members will receive 10 points per round, 5 for staging & 5 for winning. The class winner (if in points) will receive 10 additional points.
- There are no vacation points & points are earned to the driver's number not the vehicle, no one may earn points for another driver.
- All juniors must be towed or pushed to the staging lanes & back to the pits. Please have a flag for visibility. Junior Dragsters are not permitted to drive anywhere except on the track. Juniors are to use the return road directly beside the track.
- The "Track Champion" is determined after the last points race.
- If there is a tie at the end of the season, the best 2 out of 3 races will declare the winner. This will be run on the same day as the last points race. If the last points race is cancelled due to rain, the run-off date will be agreed upon by both parties.
- The points race payout is as follows: Winner \$250, Runner-up \$100 & semi-final \$50
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place trophies will also be given beginning the first points race.

- The points season payout is as follows:
 - 1st place - \$250, trophy, VIP card & VIP parking for the upcoming season & a champion jacket
 - 2nd place - \$100 & trophy
 - 3rd place - \$50
